The Root (Meta) Challenge of the 21st Century: Why Don't We Get It?

Description: We know that our apprehension of reality determines our responses to it. Our choice is to "understand or die." Given this, best we get serious about learning to see, explore, and reflexively understand & test the adequacy of our routine ways of understanding. We should pay careful attention to the work of surfacing & exploring our unconscious & implicit understandings of reality, the Earth, life, our species, our cultures, ourselves & the root challenges of our times. I shall offer reasons why we who are Modern Techno-Industrial (MTI) persons in MTI families, communities & cultures should be especially cautious. We continue to naively assume that the future belongs to us, when even now it is slipping through our fingers, I shall explain why & what options are open to us.

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








What Do We (MTI) NOT Understand?

Situation:


We do not understand that our Modern Techno-Industrial (MTI) form of civilization is already past its peak, in a state of increasing disintegration (a.k.a. simplification, collapse) [see Rees, Bendell, de Oliveira, Hagens] and will not survive the 21st Century.

Today, no MTI culture, not even one significant MTI institution, "gets it" that this is the case and has openly committed itself to re-organizing, inside and out, in order to come to understand and respond with imagination and courage.

Question:

Why? How do we account for this apparently appalling situation within MTI cultures – the very cultures which see themselves to be smartest, most science-literate problem solvers in human history?

We (MTI) Cannot Imagine This Really is Our Situation



We (MTI) Cannot Imagine that This Can Be the Case

After 1,000 years of intensifying development, it is becoming clear that the MTI way of apprehending reality, presenting ourselves to it and responding to reality (1) is not sustainable and (2) cannot be made to be sustainable. MTI cultures CANNOT be "fixed" or "solved".

Therefore, our only hope is to learn what it will take for us as MTI persons, families, communities, and jurisdictions to transcend our formation as MTI by consciously cooperating with our own evolution at every scale, and this on the basis of new apprehensions of, and responses to, reality.

Observation



It is possible to make the case that MTI cultures have no long-term future in at least two fundamentally different ways:

- 1. By using STEM. Measure "objective" features and runs the numbers.
- 2. By using the skills of the humanities. Sensitive observation, deep thought, deeper reflexivity, deeper yet meta-reflexivity.



Question

Could you write a reasonably acceptable (C+) paper on the ontological and epistemological presuppositions (OEP) of the MTI form of civilization and how they are similar to and different from the OEP of other forms of civilization and why it matters?



Why Is This Important?

If the OEP of MTI cultures can be shown to be inadequate in light of the best we now know about reality, life on Earth, including humanity, then it can reasonably be concluded that MTI cultures are ill-founded; that "the centre cannot hold;" that MTI cultures will disintegrate as it dawns on folks that there is no solid ground under their feet.







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Reality and Our Relationship to Reality

- 1. The reality we live in, in its totality, requires interpretation by H. sapiens.
- 2. Over long periods H. sapiens can develop reasonably coherent, broad and inclusive interpretations that are widely shared and accepted.
- 3. Each way of construing reality is called a "Form of Civilization."*
- 4. All human cultures, exemplify one (or more) forms of civilization.
- 5. To date, reality has been construed with extraordinary coherence by H. sapiens in three quite different ways.
- 6. Each Form of Civilization is defined and constrained by its Ontological and Epistemological presuppositions (OEP).



^{• &}quot;Forms of civilization" is a concept not yet in good currency. I coined it at a futures conference at the University of Strathclyde, Scotland in 2007.

The majority of those who live in cultures which exemplify the same civilization, unconsciously share the ways they know, imagine, think things through and conduct themselves regarding:


- The nature of reality.

The trajectory of history changes when a new civilization emerges!





Counterfactual Context Our cultural tendency is to focus on one detail at a time by deliberately removing messy contextual links so that we may scrutinize the internal logic of each piece in isolation (see Iain McGilchrist's The Master and His Emissary for insights into this phenomenon). I'm sure any of the previous sections could be made to seem less scary/dire in such a piecemeal way by intentionally ignoring the full context. But guess what: the actual real biophysical world we live in does not operate as tidy, isolated, non-interacting domains rendering invalid many of our analysis efforts, however elegant.




