

**THE OBJECTIVES
OF THE
CANADIAN ASSOCIATION
FOR
THE CLUB OF ROME**

Recorded below are the objectives of the Canadian Association for the Club of Rome as stated in its application for incorporation in 1974, section III:

(a) **to promote study and discussion** among all segments of the Canadian public of the nature of world problems and the need to develop new policies, attitudes and courses of action to ensure a stable and viable future for mankind; and **to cultivate a new humanism** that will contribute to world peace, social justice and individual well-being;

(b) **to stimulate and conduct study and research into problems of human well-being and future survival**, and the interactions and interdependence of such problems, to understand better the workings of the world as a finite system, and **to suggest alternate ways to meet critical needs**;

(c) to assess Canada's situation and identify any particular and specific aspects of it that may affect or be affected by world problems and to determine the implications for Canada of possible world solutions; **to be a catalyst in seeking solutions** and the identification of Canada's possible roles and **to promote their implementation**; and

(d) in furtherance of the objectives aforesaid, to solicit, receive and accept subscriptions, gifts, legacies, bequests, grants and other contributions.
